(Before the shopkeeper could finish his sentence, he disappeared.)




Scene 3.(In Five's village.)

But we can't do bad things! ([Angel]Anansi was very angry and left.)


[Bad]Anansi:

count the yam hills.



Bro' Bull: OK! You look at this. It is 1,2,3,4,5.....

我們的課程

- b. 建立聽,說的基礎。讓小朋友的語言回歸最自然的學習模式。


兒童班: 小一-小六,一堂課120分鐘,一週兩堂課。
